

Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program (FRWIP) On-Farm Component

The On-Farm component is designed for farmers, ranchers and Indian Bands for the development of **non-potable water supplies for agricultural use only**. Eligible projects include: on-farm wells, shallow buried pasture pipelines, deep buried pipelines and dugouts. The program will provide a cost-sharing grant of up to 50 per cent of eligible costs to a maximum of \$60,000 per applicant. Projects must have been initiated on or after March 18, 2009 to be eligible. Projects have 18 months to be completed once approval is received. Projects started after March 19, 2008, and prior to March 18, 2009, may be retroactively eligible. To be eligible, retroactive applicants must have submitted an application to the **Canada-Saskatchewan Water Supply Expansion Program (CSWSEP)** in 2008. Application deadline for retroactive projects is June 30, 2009, and projects must be completed by November 1, 2009. Eligible retroactive projects that received funding through CSWSEP can apply for a top-up payment of up to 50 per cent of eligible expenses under FRWIP. Project approvals and payment on claims are subject to the terms and conditions of the Canada/Saskatchewan Bilateral Agreement on Growing Forward and the applicant obtaining all necessary permits and approvals associated with the eligible project.

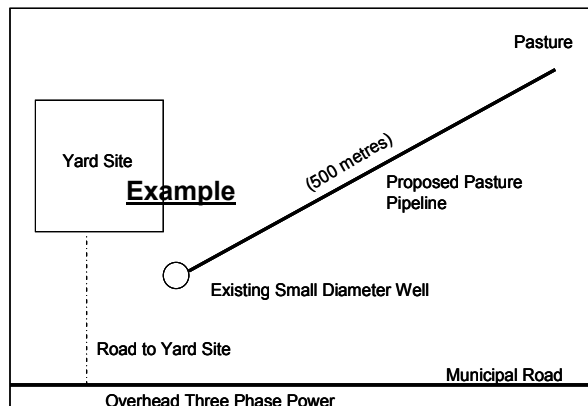


Diagram of Project

3. I declare that no other application for the Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program has been made, or is to be made, for the eligible project that is the subject of this application.
4. I certify that the eligible project meets the requirements set out in the program guidelines attached to this application.
5. I promise to provide further information, including access to our project records, that the program may reasonably require and to inform the program administration of any changes to the application information for the purpose of administering this application. I further authorize:
 - (a) the program to request information about the Applicant or the Applicant's project from any federal or provincial government department or agency, or from any third party including, but not limited to, the Prairie Farm Rehabilitation Administration (PFRA), and to disclose any information contained in this application or provided in relation to the Applicant, to any such department, agency or third party, including but not limited to, the Prairie Farm Rehabilitation Administration (PFRA), for the purposes of processing this application or administering this program;
 - (b) any department, agency or third party mentioned above who is requested to verify or provide information, to disclose that information to the program; and
 - (c) this program to disclose information in relation to the Applicant, to any such department, agency or third party including but not limited to the Prairie Farm Rehabilitation Administration (PFRA), for the purposes of processing this application or administering this program.

 - (b) relating to injury (including death) to persons or loss of or damage to property arising out of the negligence or wilful misconduct of the Applicant, its contractors, officers, agents or employees; or
 - (c) arising out of the work undertaken by the Applicant pursuant to this project including, but not limited to, claims for builders' liens, workers' compensation, employment insurance, holidays, back pay or any rates or charges.
