

The Canadian Agricultural Partnership (CAP) is a five-year, \$388 million investment by federal and provincial governments in strategic initiatives for Saskatchewan agriculture. Programs include:

Farm Stewardship Program:

Provides Saskatchewan producers funding to implement beneficial management practices (BMPs) in three priority areas – water, climate change and biodiversity

Pre-approval:

- Drainage Stewardship
- Environmental Solutions
- Invasive Plant Biocontrol and Targeted Grazing
- Livestock Stewardship
- Native Rangeland Grazing Management
- Permanent Native Forage
- Permanent Tame Forage
- Riparian Grazing Management

Rebate:

- Variable Rate Mapping BMP

Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program:

Supports the development of secure and sustainable water sources for agricultural use in Saskatchewan; Mitigates the impact of drought; and Improves public safety and reduces potential groundwater contamination through well decommissioning

Rebate: Dugout, pipeline, and wells

Pre-Approval: Well Decommissioning and Special Projects
